# FOUNDATION CLASSES

Wednesday Evenings 7-9.30pm OR Saturdays 10am-5pm

The Foundation course is designed for complete newcomers to astrology as well as for those who wish to consolidate their previous knowledge and reading within a structured course. It aims to provide you with a basic understanding of the language of astrology and the ability to interpret the basic birth chart with confidence. You will learn to calculate and draw up a horoscope, and you will be introduced to the solar system, the seasonal year and to the astronomical basis of the birth chart. You will also be introduced to the history of western astrology and encouraged to explore your own ideas about the nature of astrology.

Completion of the Foundation course is a significant achievement in itself and will provide you with a solid basis for more advanced study. On completion, each Foundation Course module also attracts 20 credits towards the Faculty's Diploma qualification - full details of the credit-based qualification system can be found in our general Prospectus available from the Faculty website.
