ARRIVAL AND REGISTRATION

The Abbey House is on Chilkwell Street, Glastonbury BA6 8DH. Parking is available.

On arrival, you should collect your room key from the Reception Desk. You will then be directed to the Winter Weekend Welcome Desk in order to register with us.

YOUR STAY AT THE ABBEY HOUSE

General

Towels are provided by the Abbey House and the majority of rooms share bathroom facilities, although rooms have their own wash basin.

There is a vending machine downstairs and two kitchenettes stocked with range of hot drinks, fresh milk and confectionary. Personal items and medication can be stored in the kitchenette fridges.

Wi-Fi

The Abbey House does not provide wi-fi access. However, it is possible to access wi-fi in numerous cafés on Glastonbury High Street, although reception can be poor in the area generally.

Abbey Grounds

Groups staying at the Abbey House enjoy the privilege of being able to access the Abbey grounds through a private gate. Details of access times will be made available to you on arrival.

Travel

Train

The nearest stations are Castle Cary (closest), Taunton and Bristol Temple Meads. Taunton and Bristol Temple Meads both offer a bus service from the station to Glastonbury but Castle Cary is a little more remote and it is advisable to take a taxi (approximately £25; travelling time 30 minutes).

By Bus

Service 376 from Bristol Bus Station. This bus also serves Bristol Temple Meads, and the journey time is approximately 90 minutes.

Service 29 from Taunton Railway Station. This takes approximately 90 minutes.

By Car

On arriving in Glastonbury from M5 or A39 from Wells, follow the signs for Town Centre. Drive all the way to the top of the High Street and at the T-junction turn right. Drive through the traffic calming chicane and almost immediately the entrance to Abbey House is on the right (opposite Dod Lane). There is ample parking on site.

If you are arriving on the A361 from Shepton Mallet, as you approach Glastonbury there is a mini roundabout. Go straight across. You will see the high, stone perimeter wall of the Abbey on your left. The entrance to Abbey House is on the left, just before the traffic calming chicane.

Airport

The nearest airport is Bristol.

You can either take a taxi (£50 pre-booked Glastonbury taxi; £70 airport taxi, travelling time approximately 45 minutes) or there is an airport bus to take you into Bristol, where you can change onto the Glastonbury bus (Service 376).

Airport Bus

The Airport Flyer is the only dedicated express service linking Bristol City centre, Clifton and connecting rail and bus networks with Bristol Airport. The service now runs every 10 minutes during peak times from Bristol Bus Station and local bus networks.

The service operates two routes:

A1: Bristol Airport - Bedminster - Temple Meads Railway Station - Cabot Circus - Bristol Bus Station (this service operates in both directions)

A2: Bristol Airport - Bedminster - Temple Meads Railway Station - Broad Quay (City Centre) - Clifton - Bristol Bus Station (this service operates Bristol-bound only)
